



E-TOLL PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Travelling across Sydney is quicker and easier with the introduction of a number of tollways. E tags issued by any toll motorway in Australia are valid to use on all motorways in New South Wales. If you travel on a tollway without an electronic tag, cash, or credit card**, payment can be made at the cash booths immediately for those Motorways offering cash lane operations. Cash booths also offer the option to defer payment* to a later date.

Tolls are the renters responsibility and must be purchased directly from the tollway operator to avoid fines and administration fees.

The following roads do offer both ELECTRONIC TAG AND CASH lane operations: If you have travelled on a tollway without making payment, please follow the instructions outlined below.

M2 MOTORWAY - Links the lower North Shore and Northwest Sydney

Toll payment both directions

Phone (02) 9869 4177 or (02) 9869 4444 with registration plate, time, date and direction travelled (city or outbound) for further instruction.

M4 MOTORWAY – Western Motorway

Toll payment both directions

Phone 1300 88 0099 to arrange payment or write a cheque or money order. You must include name, address, registration plate, time, date and direction travelled (city or westbound) on back of slip. Make cheque or money order payable to Statewide Roads and send to Locked Bag 267, Silverwater, NSW 1811. To be paid within 7 days.

M5 MOTORWAY – South Western Motorway

Toll payment both directions

Phone 1300 658 652 to arrange payment or write a cheque or money order. To be paid within 7 days. Make cheque or money order payable to Interlink Roads and send to: Interlink Roads, PO Box 700, Moorebank, NSW 1875.

EASTERN DISTRIBUTOR (ED) -Links Cahill Expressway at Woolloomooloo and Southern Cross Drive at Zetland

Northbound toll

Phone (02) 8356 2200 between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday to register an e-toll violation. Have registration plate, time and date details ready. Or write a cheque or money order.

HARBOUR BRIDGE

Southbound toll

If payment is not made at the TOLL Booth an infringement notice will be issued by Sydney Harbour Bridge and Hertz Administration fee will be charged. Payment can be made on the day at the TOLL booth or after the infringement notice has been issued a Cheque or Money Order, with the registration plate, time and date is required. Payable to RTA and send it to: Sydney Harbour Bridge Toll Office, PO Box 137, Milsons Point, NSW 1565.

THE FOLLOWING ROADS DO NOT ALLOW CASH PAYMENTS. ELECTRONIC TAG OR TEMPORARY PASS ONLY:

LANE COVE TUNNEL - Links North Shore and M2

Toll payment both directions

The Lane Cove Tunnel and Falcon Street Gateway are fully electronic and require either a tag or a pass for payment of the toll. You will be charged each time that you use the Tunnel and the Gateway. The charge depends on the size of your vehicle and the route you take. Call Roam Express on 137 626 to arrange a temporary visitors E-Pass, or call within 24 hours to advise of a toll violation.

CROSS CITY TUNNEL - Links Eastern Suburbs and Western Distributor with North Sydney and airport exits

Toll payment both directions

Cost is variable depending on which part of the Cross City Tunnel you use. Call Customer Service Centre on: (02) 9033 3999 to set up a 1 to 7 day pass or to advise of a toll violation.

M7 MOTORWAY – Links M2, M4 and M5

Toll payment both directions

Phone: 138 655 to set up a Visitors e-pass either before, or up to 24 hours after your first trip on the M7. Or get an e-pass at roam.com.au. Cost is variable depending on which part of the M7 you use. There is a maximum toll for a single continuous trip on Westlink M7.

HARBOUR TUNNEL

Motorists will need an electronic tag to use the Sydney Harbour Tunnel. Electronic tags can be ordered online from RTA E-Toll at www.myrta.com.
